Fact Sheet on the conflict in and about Northern Ireland



- Every day of the year marks the anniversary of someone's death as a result of conflict in and about Northern Ireland.¹
- Over 3,720 people were killed as a result of the conflict.²
- Approximately 47,541 people were injured.³
- There were 36,923 shootings.⁴
- 16,209 bombings were conducted.⁵
- From 1969 to 1998, 1,533 of the deaths as a result of the conflict were under the age of 25. 257 of those killed were under the age of 18. ⁶
- The largest age group (25% or 898 people) killed between 1969 and 1998 were those between the ages of 18 and 23.7
- The largest group (54% by 1998) of the deaths as a result of the conflict were civilians.⁸
- The largest group (68% by 1998) of those injured were civilian.⁹
